

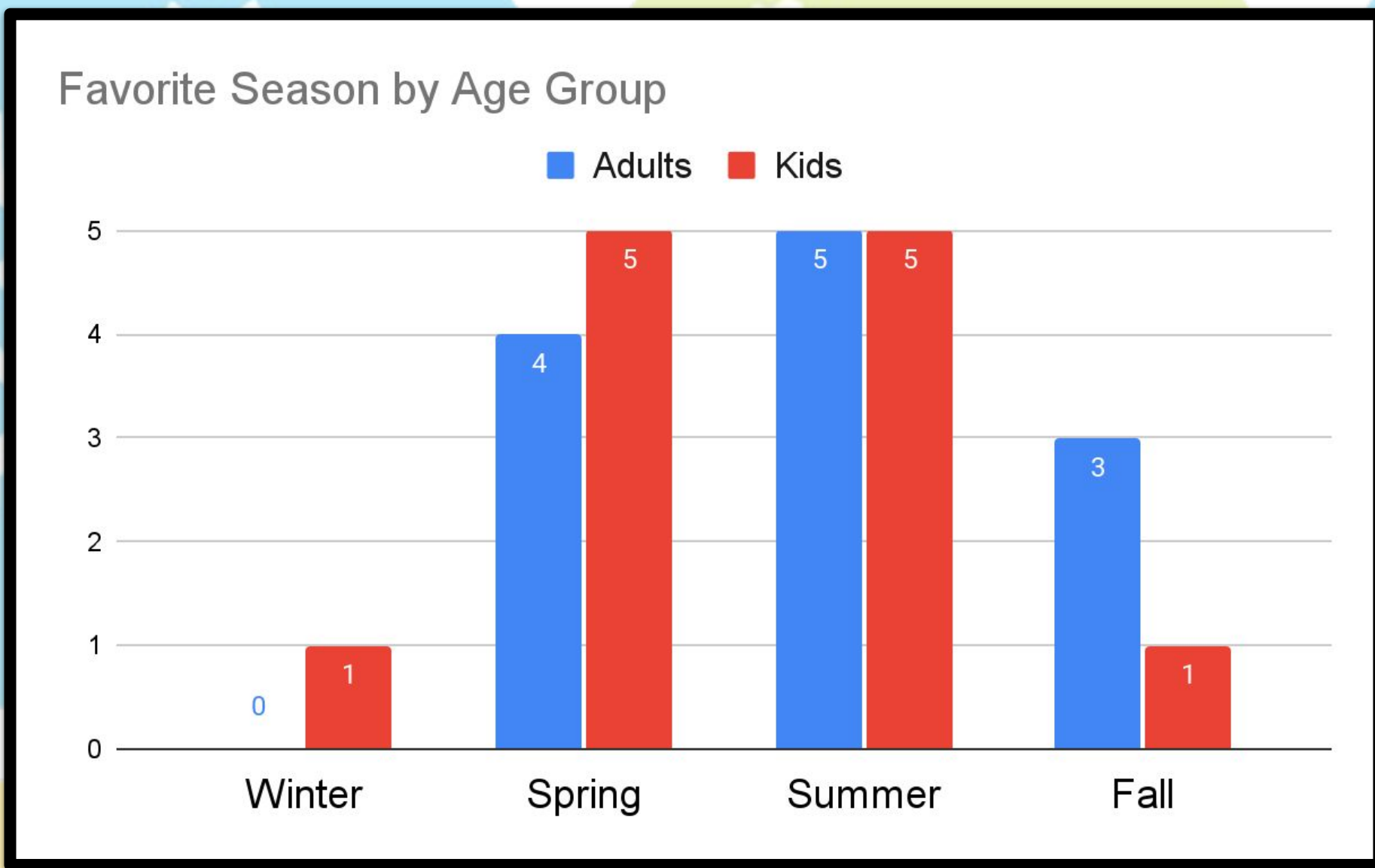
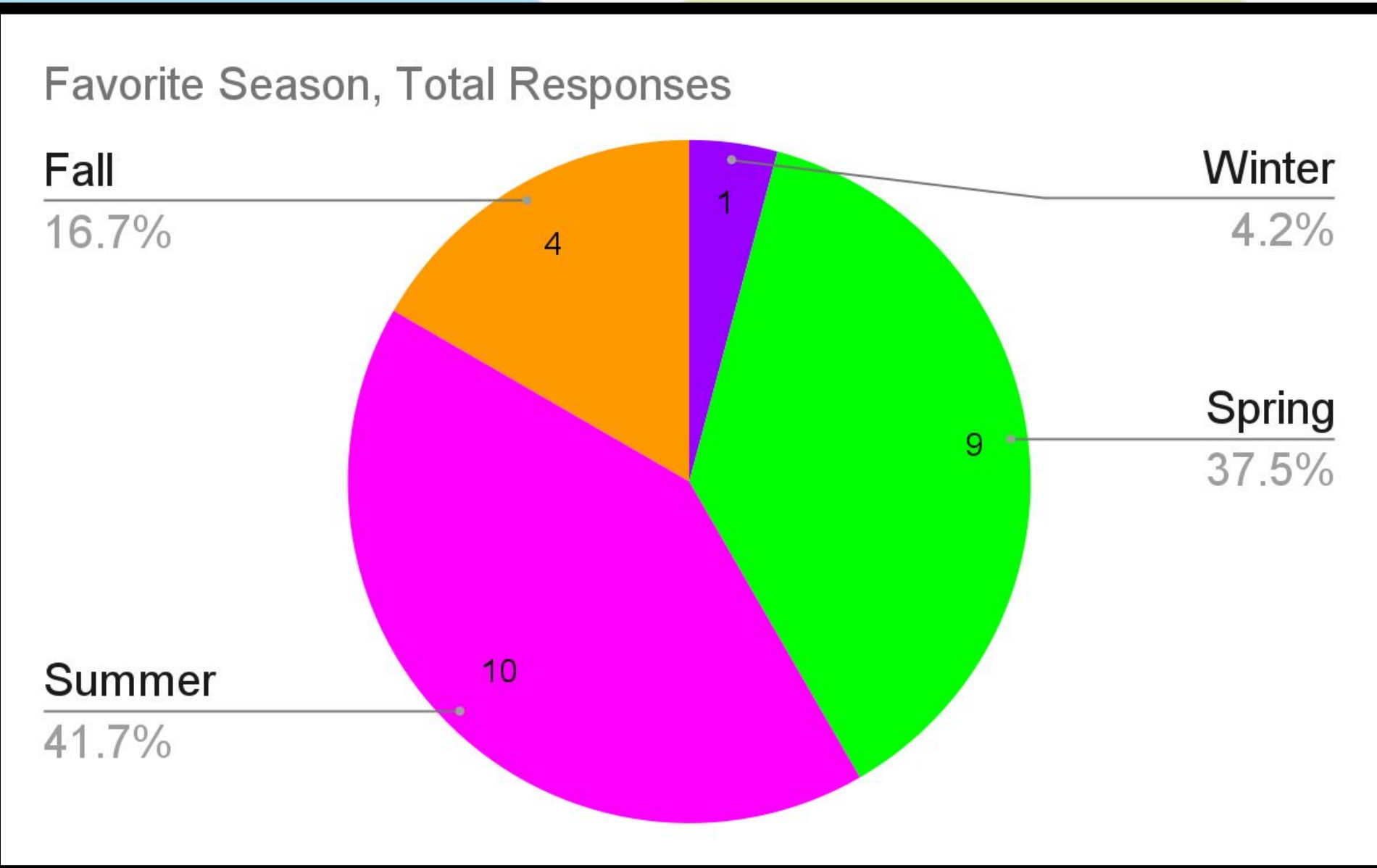
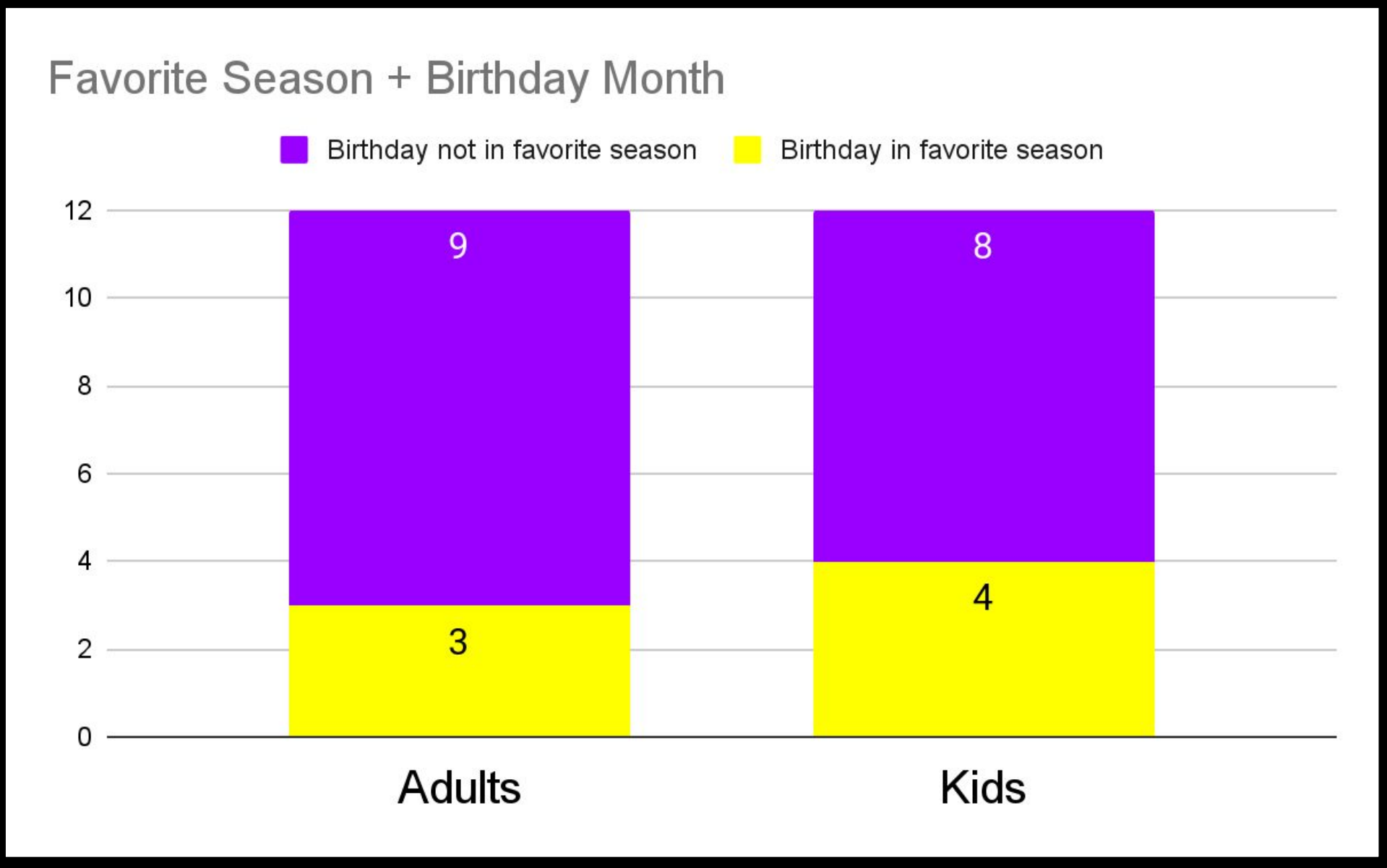
A Study For All Seasons

Question: What is your favorite season?

Method: With my mom's help, we texted or instant messaged 12 adults and 12 kids the same question: *What is your favorite season? You can answer winter, spring, summer, or fall.* Then, we wrote down everyone's birthday months and graphed them against their favorite season.

Purpose: Spring is my favorite season because that's when my birthday is. I wondered if other people felt the same way— does their favorite season depend on their birthday month?

Hypothesis: I think that summer will be most people's favorite season, with or without their birthday, but more kids than adults will pick the season that their birthday is in as their favorite season.



Results: Kids' favorite season were tied between summer and spring and adults' favorite season was summer. More adults than kids had birthdays not during their favorite season than during.

Conclusion: My hypothesis was partly right. Most people chose summer as their favorite season. But, more people, both adults and kids, had a favorite season that did not include their birthday month. This is interesting to me because it shows me that everyone has favorite things, like seasons or even foods or TV shows, based on unique things they like and find important.
